## **Key Travel Details**

### **Registration Period:**

Registration opens May 1, 2017 and closes at 40 travelers. This trip will sell out so we strongly encourage early registration. To register and secure your space, please go to [www.global-academics.org](http://www.global-academics.org) at the top right hand of the Home Page click on “Register Here First” and follow the directions. You will be creating an account and password, be able to pay online and receive invoices to pay overtime.

### **Cost of Tour and Payment Plan:**

NADOHE MEMBER RATE

\$2,200.00 USD Per Person: *Installment Plan*- Pay overtime May 1, 2017 - November 1, 2017. Costs include double occupancy hotel accommodations in Accra at the [Labadi Beach Hotel](#), all breakfasts and listed hosted meals, all scheduled lectures/ museum/ tour entry fees, in-country bus transportation, and guides. Cost does not include RT airfare to and from Accra, travel visa, immunizations, tips, nor meals not indicated.

NON-NADOHE MEMBER RATE

Add an additional \$200 per person to the above rate. All proceeds benefit the work of NADOHE

ADD \$700 for single room occupancy

### **Flight, Visa & Immunizations:**

1. Travelers are to purchase their airfare, visa and immunizations, as it is not included in the tour. Travelers for this tour will be coming from various cities so it is best to search the internet and/or see your local travel agent. A few recommendations are *Delta Airlines* from NYC, *South African Airlines* from Washington DC (Dulles International) and *Emirates Airlines*. It is strongly recommended that travelers purchase airfare before the end of June 2017 because prices increase and sell out due to many Ghanaians heading home for the holidays.

2. Tourist Travel Visas to Ghana are easy to secure for U.S. citizens. Please visit the US Ghana Embassy site for instructions [Ghana Embassy for Visas](#). They recommend that travelers apply for their visas 3 months in advance of travel and you must have your airfare purchased in advance. ALSO, note that you must have a valid passport that does not expire 6 months before or after our travel dates so please check and renew your passport far in advance if needed.

3. There are required and recommended immunizations to travel to Ghana. Contact a Travel Nurse or your doctor for details. Here is an article that gives a good overview [Travel Tips: Immunizations for Ghana](#)
